## Placarding of containers used exclusively in a road transport operation

## Transmitted by Government of Portugal

- 1. Portugal has initiated the multilateral agreement M218, facing some problems occurred in the international transport between Portugal and other countries.
- 2. According to that agreement, "by derogation from sub-section 5.3.1.2, placards need not be affixed on containers which are used exclusively in a road transport operation, except those carrying dangerous goods of classes 1 or 7".
- 3. At the end of validity of M218, Portugal would propose a new similar agreement, or, before this date, we could propose an amendment to 5.3.1.2 in the same direction.
- 5. Portugal would like to know the view of WP.15 on this matter.
