World Water Forum:

- The **largest international** forum in the water sector involving various stakeholders
- The Forum is held every three years and has been taking place since 1997
- The World Water Forum is not just a conference: it includes a three-year preparation phase (preparatory phase), a one-week event (event phase), and a presentation of the results (synthesis phase) with ongoing support for collective action

The main missions of the World Water Forum 2024 are to:

- provide a platform for all stakeholders in the water sector to engage, exchange, learn together, and catalyze concrete ideas for improved water resources management and development
- encourage innovative thinking to overcome contemporary and critical water resource management issues
- mobilize action by policy and decision-makers on commitments for improved water resources management and development
