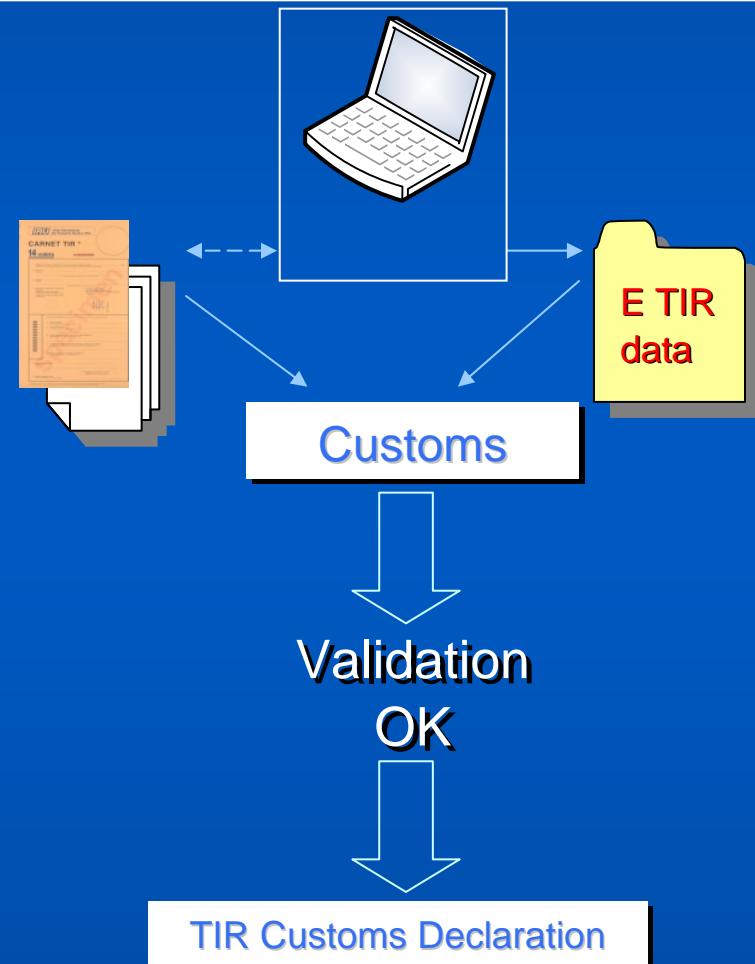

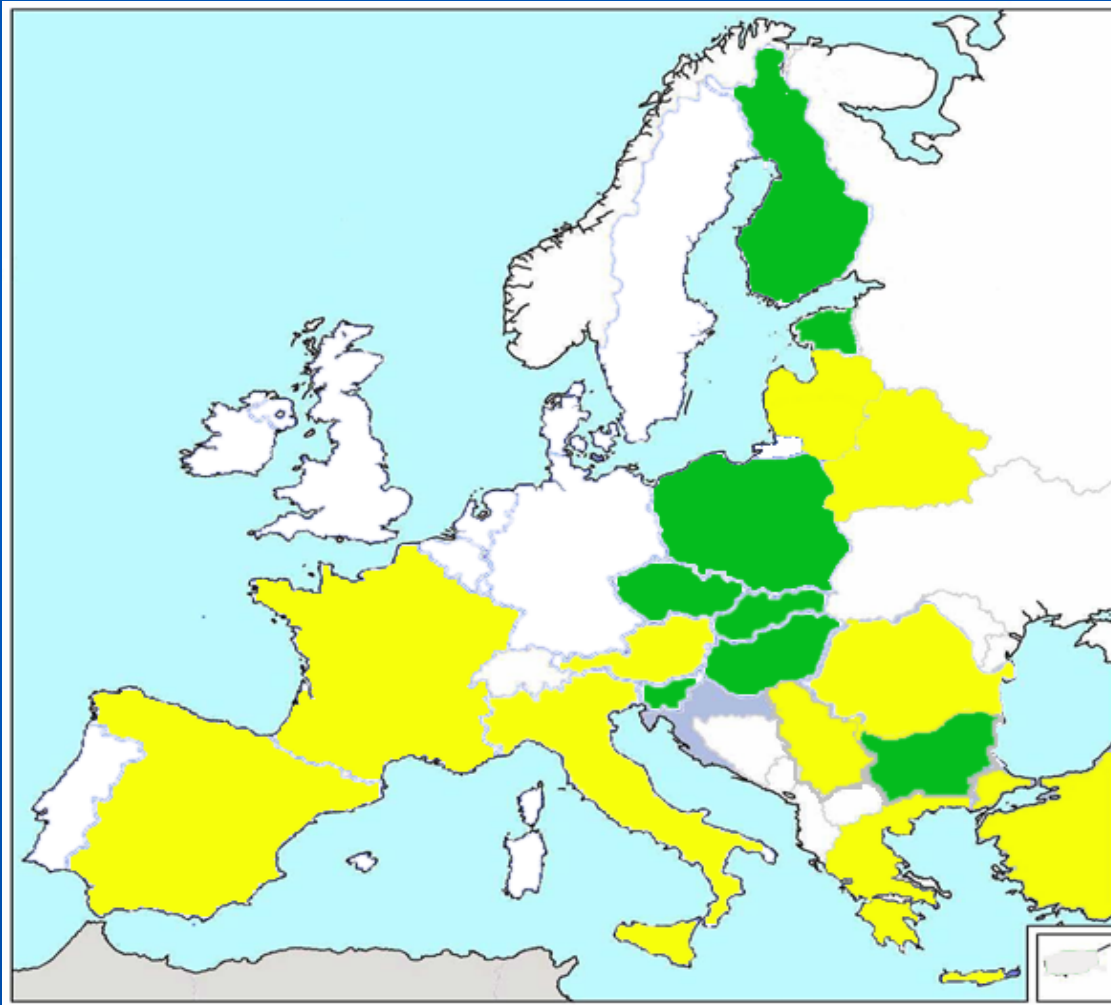

IRU TIR Electronic Pre-Declarations: Public-Private Partnership

Private sector:

- Non-discrimination on nationality, language and residence
- No additional costs in international trade

- Transparency and harmonisation
- No procedures at borders
- No waiting times at borders

Public sector:

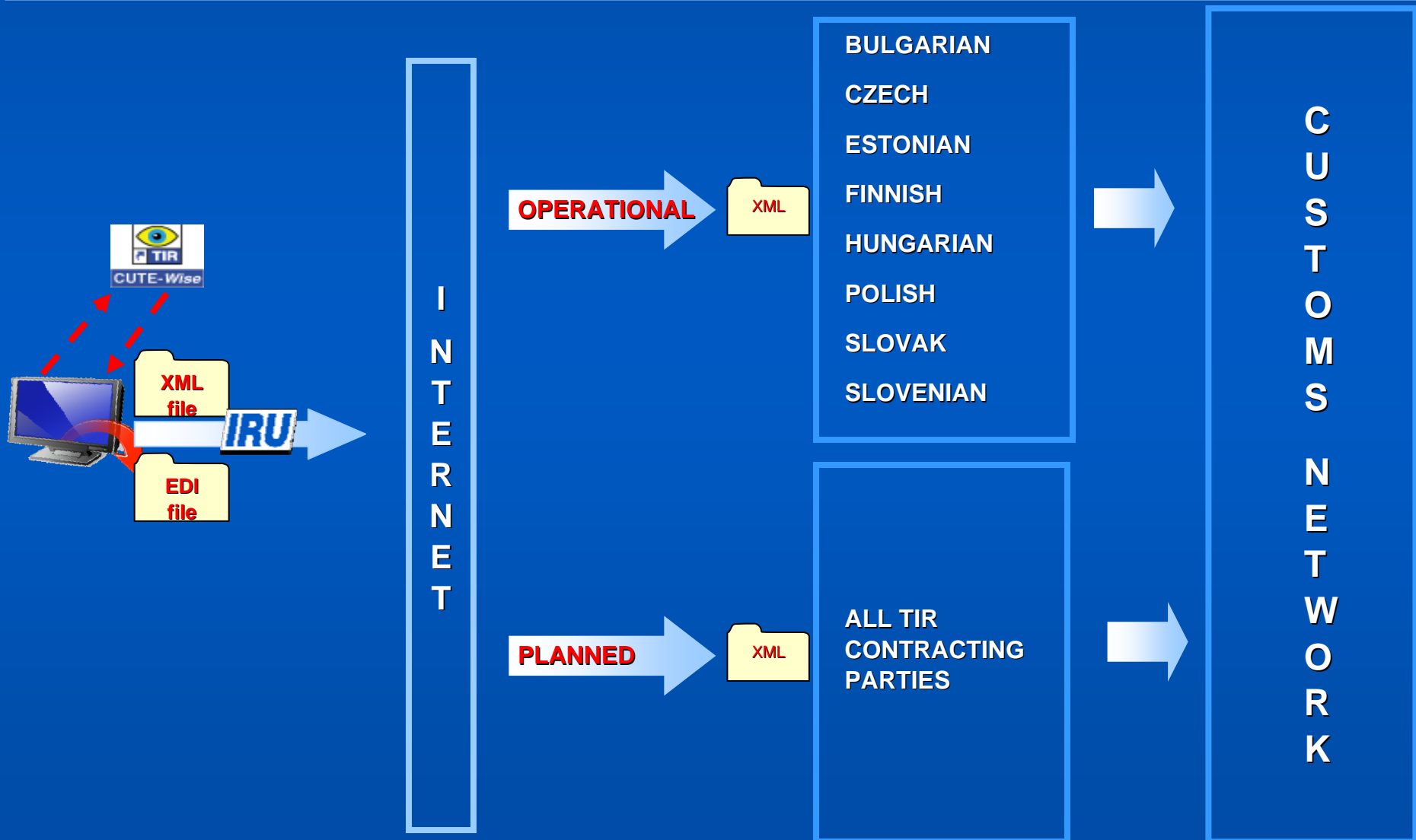
- Risk Assessment by Customs Authorities
- Security in international trade



As per Annex 8 Harmonisation of the Frontier Controls of Goods of 1982

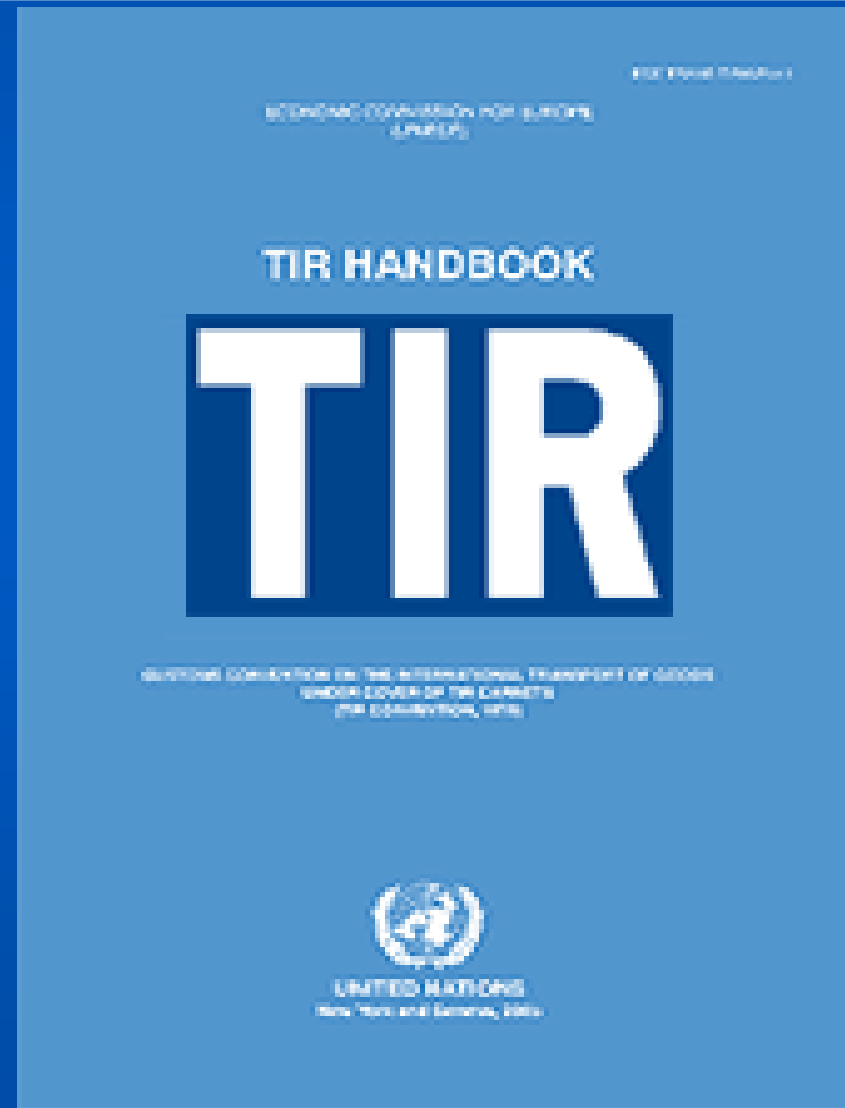

How to Further Develop IRU TIR-EPD?

IRU TIR-EPD is already implemented in 8 countries but could further be expanded if the Customs Authorities apply:

- Harmonisation and standardisation of data sets
- Harmonisation of communication and data protocols in a B2C and C2B environment
- Harmonised technology
- Harmonisation of messages between Customs



Lack of Harmonisation = Money Wasted!

- Result:
 - Recourse to third parties at borders
 - Increased waiting times



Several millions of euros lost for the economy!

This IRU Resolution aims at ensuring the appropriate standardisation and harmonisation of (B2C) and (C2C) IT communication and data protocols

Urgently calls upon the competent authorities to:

1. Apply the same standardised and harmonised communication and data protocols;
2. Implement standardised regulations regarding the appropriate IT communication protocols to ensure equal treatment of all TIR operators;
3. Ensure in the future that any new Customs regulations are properly consulted with all key role players in the TIR System.
