


Geographic Location

Ningbo Port is located in the middle of the coastline of eastern China and in the most developed Yangtze river delta.


The distance between Ningbo and Shanghai is only 120 nautical miles.








Cargo Throughput Growth of Ningbo Port




Container Throughput Growth of Ningbo Port





2000-2007 GDP Growth of China




Unit: 100 million RMB

2000-2007 Import & export volume growth of China




Unit: 100 million US dollars







2001-2007 GDP growth comparison of Yangtze river delta with that of the whole China









Main import & export trade countries and regions for the hinterland of Ningbo Port




Currently, the import and export trade areas for the hinterland of Ningbo Port are mainly European Union, United states, south east Asia, Japan, and etc.










Continue to develop sea-railway Intermodal transport










Currently, Ningbo Port has 204 shipping lines, among which 114 are ocean-going main lines.

The number of regular shipping services per month reaches over 900.






