COUNTERFEIT ATP CERTIFICATESTransmitted by the United Kingdom**Introduction**

In light of the recent problem experienced by the competent authority in Serbia regarding counterfeit ATP certificates, we propose that all competent authorities are issued with a sample of each of the 47 contracting parties ATP certificates for cross reference purposes only.

These should be confidential between authorities.

Impact

There is no financial impact to industry. The benefit would be that the competent authority could easily and quickly compare suspicious documents to those supplied and if doubts emerged contact the competent authority in question.
