










New railway Hayraton – Mazar-e-sharif





Annual growth of the number of foreign aircraft transiting via Uzbekistan 12%

The company offers flights to more than 40 international destinations In 2010 were served more than 2 mln. passengers, performed service for 23 000 flights and technical maintenance for 5 770 aircrafts.

Flying fleet of Uzbekistan Airways

- Nowadays flying stock of Uzbekistan Airways consist of 16 modern planes (Boeing Dreamliner, Airbus, RJ)
- In particular, until 2015 planned to purchase 16 new medium-and long-haul passenger aircrafts, including "Boeing" (6 units) and "Airbus" (10 units), and nowadays have been delivered 10 "Airbus" and 2 "Boeing"



Automobile transport

Share of automobile transport in foreign trade freight transportations is around 10% as well as 88% in domestic passenger and freight transportations.

Growth rates of automobile services volume account to 20% annually.





- Provides a full range of freight forwarding, cargo handling services, container transportation, storage, customs clearance and certification of goods








Accepting and processing freights and their transportation to Andijan, Namangan and Ferghana regions with the help of road transport

Will be transported 6 million tones cargo in year, including spare parts for vehicles and ready products of GM Uzbekistan, oil products and others

International Logistic Center «Tashkent»





- Logistic center will locate 2 km away from Tashkent ring road, 3 km from freight station Sergili and 7 km away from city airport;
- The center will have covered with 5 warehouses, 2 container areas for vehicles, 4 parking areas for trucks, rail and road;
- On initial stage it will be used to storage of cotton fiber, packed, loose oversized and frozen freights

Development of Transport Communications

Prior to 2015, implementation of projects more \$ 7 bln including road sector 3. 4 bln, railway 1.6 bln air transport 1 bln and 1,3 bln in telecommunications, engineering and communication sector is envisaged.
