#### Introduction

- 1. At WP.11's seventy-second session in 2016, some changes to the questionnaire (terminology changes and clarifications) were suggested and the secretariat was asked to consolidate them (see ECE/TRANS/WP.11/235 para 26). Consequently, the secretariat requested Contracting Parties to send their comments for consolidation in a new proposal for the seventy-third session.
