Summary

At its 2023 session, the Specialized Section reviewed a proposal by the delegation of Germany to amend the informal reference list of citrus fruit varieties (ECE/CTCS/WP.7/GE.1/2023/10). The Specialized Section noted that while it is an informal document it is used by many traders and inspection bodies as a guide. As the document contained some inconsistencies, the Specialized Section agreed to establish an ad-hoc working group consisting of Brazil, Germany, South Africa (rapporteur) and Spain to conduct a review of the informal reference list of citrus fruit varieties. The working group met in two online meetings on 30 November 2023 and 5 February 2024.

The following revised informal reference list of citrus fruit varieties is submitted by the ad-hoc working group for the consideration of the Specialized Section.

To facilitate the review, this document can be read with document ECE/CTCS/WP.7/GE.1/2024/INF.1 which shows the changes as compared to the 2023 document in track-change format.



I. Introduction¹

1. The informal list of citrus fruit varieties was developed by the Specialized Section on Standardization of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables, a subsidiary body of the Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE).

2. The purpose of this informal list of citrus varieties is to serve as a guide to inspection bodies, growers, packers, exporters, importers and retailers. The list is not meant to be exhaustive. Varieties not mentioned in the list can still be traded if they satisfy the requirements of the UNECE standard FFV-14 for the marketing and commercial quality control of citrus fruit.

3. Some of the varieties in the following list may be marketed under names for which trademark protection has been sought or obtained in one or more countries. Names believed by the Specialized Section on Standardization of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables / Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards to be varietal names are listed in the first column. Other names by which the Specialized Section on Standardization of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables / Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards believes the variety may be known are listed in the second column. None of these two columns is intended to include trademarks. References to known trademarks have been included in the third column for information only. The presence of any trademarks in the third column does not constitute any licence or permission to use that trademark – such licence must come directly from the trademark owner. In addition, the absence of a trademark in the third column does not constitute any indication that there is no registered/pending trademark for such a variety. For labelling requirements please refer to section VI of the UNECE standard FFV-14 concerning the marketing and commercial quality control of citrus fruit.²

4. The following list is based on the scientific names as agreed for the standard. It includes:

- the changes agreed for the Citrus fruit standard at the April 2016 session of the Specialized Section on Standardization of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables.
- the contributions to the Specialized Section meeting in 2017 from Italy, Morocco, the Netherlands, South Africa, Spain, and the United States of America (as of 2 March 2017).

² Some of the varietal names listed in the first column may indicate varieties for which patent protection has been obtained in one or more countries. Such proprietary varieties may only be produced or traded by those authorized by the patent holder to do so under an appropriate licence. The Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards endeavoured to ensure that no trademark names are listed in columns 1, and 2 of the table. However, it is the responsibility of any trademark owner to notify the secretariat of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe if a trademark name has been included in the table and to provide the secretariat (see address below) with an appropriate varietal, or generic name for the variety, as well as adequate evidence ownership of any applicable patent or trademark regarding such variety so that the list can be amended. Provided that no further information is needed from the trademark holder, the Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards will revise the list accordingly at the session following receipt of the information. The United Nations takes no position as to the validity of any such trademarks or the rights of any such trademark owners or their licensees.
