





## Legal framework: Grounding the recommendations

- Statistical framework:
  Who to include and how to define different groups
- Statistics, indicators & tabulations: What data to collect and statistics to produce
- Data sources:
   How different data sources can be used/improved on
- Coordination:
   How national, regional and international statistical coordination can be capitalized on/improved

## Refugee Statistical Framework

#### Persons in need of international protection

1. Prospective asylum seekers

2. Asylum seekers

Persons with determined protection status

i. Refugees

 ii. Admitted for complementary and subsidiary forms of protection

iii. Admitted for temporary protection

4. Others in refugee-like situations

#### Persons with a refugee background

1. Naturalized former refugees

2. Children born of refugee parents

 Reunified refugee family members from abroad

4. Others with a refugee background

Persons returned from abroad after seeking international protection (returnees)

1. Repatriating refugees


2. Repatriating asylum seekers

 Others returning from seeking international protection abroad




## IDP Statistical Framework
