Azerbaijan holds one of the first places in the world for per capita IDP rate. 1 million refugees and IDPs is a huge burden for the Azerbaijan's economy. educational institutions were situated in the occupied territories. About 131,000 students as well as
20,000 employees of the educational system became IDPs. Most of the refugees from Armenia and
IDPs from occupied territories were temporarily housed in the buildings of kindergartens and
schools. The Government of Azerbaijan has to eliminate the results of the occupation after the
liberation of the 20 % of its territories.
