PROPOSAL FOR DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION No. 112

(Headlamps emitting an asymmetrical passing beam)

A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 6.3.2., amend to read:

"6.3.2. It is possible to use a second light source for the driving beam, this light source being listed in Regulation No. 37. The following provisions shall be met:"

B. JUSTIFICATION

The proposal is intended to align the provisions on light sources for the driving beam in Regulation No. 112 to those in Regulation No. 98, and thus to permit the design of driving beam headlamps with two light sources.
