A. INTRODUCTION

The French proposal, contained in document TRANS/WP.29/GRB/1999/2, referring to wide section tyres, seems to be acceptable; however the following amendments are proposed.

B. PROPOSAL

- (ii) Paragraph 2.5.1., (document TRANS/WP.29/GRB/1999/2), the required load capacity index "LI > 121" should be deleted
- (ii) In order to take account of the noise level produced by tyres fitted on the front axle, the result of noise measurement should be reduced by [3] dBA. */
 However, if the noise level produced by wide section (single) tyres and by the front axle tyres is lower than the noise limit, the deduction can be omitted.

C. JUSTIFICATION

- (i) Wide section (single) tyres exist in Japan.
- (ii) To take account of the noise produced by tyres fitted on the front axle.
