GRPE agreed to resume its consideration of the proposal by Japan to align the Regulation with ISO standards and the corresponding EC Directive.

GRPE agreed to have a final review of the proposal for a Supplement to the Regulation, intended to differentiate by marking components for very low temperatures and to introduce provisions for dualfuel engines. GRPE also agreed to consider the proposal by Italy clarifying the manual valve device requirements.
