PROVISIONAL ANNOTATED AGENDA FOR THE FORTY-SIXTH SESSION 1/2/3/

to be held at the Palais des Nations, Geneva, from Monday, 19 May 2003, 09.30h, to Friday, 23 May 2003, 17.30h

The forty-sixth session was initially scheduled to be held from 20 to 23 May 2003. However, during its last session (TRANS/WP.29/GRPE/45, para. 65), GRPE decided to start the session on Monday, 19 May 2003 with the informal meetings, without interpretation. At the request of the Chairman of the informal group on non-road mobile machinery (NRMM), the secretariat agreed to hold a meeting of the NRMM group after the GRPE proper session, on Friday afternoon, without interpretation. These modifications to the agenda are subject to confirmation by WP.29 at its one-hundred-and-twenty-ninth session in March 2003. Full interpretation will only be provided from Tuesday afternoon to Friday morning, but not on Monday, Tuesday morning and Friday afternoon.
