


## Appendix A: Categorization of Injuries

Injury Description	Injury Category
Hip joint injury (various)	Hip/Pelvis
Femur fracture: head, intertrochanteric, neck	Hip/Pelvis
Pelvis fracture, sacroilium fracture	Hip/Pelvis
Symphysis pubis separation	Hip/Pelvis
Amputation above knee	Thigh
Femoral vessel injury (various)	Thigh
Femur fracture: site NFS	Thigh
Femur fracture: shaft, supratrochanteric, or subtrochanteric	Thigh
Femur fracture: codes not listed in AIS-90, update 98 manual	Thigh
Popliteal vessel injury (various)	Knee
Collateral or cruciate lig. laceration - knee	Knee
Collateral or cruciate lig. laceration - PCL	Knee
Knee joint injury (various)	Knee
Femur fracture: condylar	Knee
Patella fracture	Knee
Tibial condyles/plateau/intercondyloid spine fracture	Knee
Amputation below knee, entire foot, calcaneus	Lower leg
Fibula fracture: Site NFS	Lower leg
Fibula fracture: Head, neck, shaft	Lower leg
Tibia fracture NFS	Lower leg
Tibial shaft fracture	Lower leg
Tibia injury, NFS	Lower leg
