Why Powered two-wheelers (PTWs)?

- Inexpensive Mobility
- Leisure, tourism and sport
- Employment, (3,5 4 million people globally)
- Useful in commerce and the public services (police, medical care)
- So, and increasing market (152 to 300 million in-use in the last decade)



Trends and Solutions

- PTW riders are vulnerable road users
- Developed country trends are mostly down but developing countries lack data
- Effective countermeasures need reliable data (Moscow conference conclusion)
- IMMA believes that rider safety throughout the world will be improved by the application of the safe system approach




Headlight

Essential for night-time safety

Also provides conspicuity in daytime (being visible on the road)

Research shows that perception failures by other drivers are a dominant cause of accidents and that this is because of poor conspicuity.



Helmet



The wearing of an approved and properly fitting helmet is a proven aid in reducing the consequences of an accident.

If you don't do up the strap, you could lose a lot more than your helmet.



The Road

The road must have a smooth and regular surface

It must be properly maintained and avoid slippery elements e.g. manhole covers





The roadway environment has to be "forgiving" in the event of an accident

Crash-barriers should be integrated into roadway design and their supports shrouded to protect riders

Training



PTW training varies but training should always include:

- control skills
- risk awareness and avoidance

knowledge of a PTW's

limitations

Car drivers need training in PTW awareness

Conclusion

- HHRT are the basic road safety elements for riders of PTWs
- Until these have been introduced, other measures will have no noticeable effect
- Improving rider safety requires thorough research, clear objectives and partnership between the stakeholders
- There is a lot of specialist literature available, it needs to be pulled together into a set of guidelines that are appropriate for each situation
