## A. PROPOSAL

Insert a new paragraph 3.1.15. and its corresponding footnote 5/, to read:

"3.1.15. the inscriptions "M/C" after the rim diameter marking, for tyres with rim diameter code 13 and above 5/.

5/ This marking shall apply on all relevant tyre sidewalls only after  $\overline{01}$  January 2003

Paragraph 4.1.9., the reference to footnote 5/ (former) and the footnote , renumber as footnote 6/.

Paragraph 5.4.1., the reference to footnote  $\underline{6}$  (former) and the footnote , renumber as footnote  $\underline{7}$ , and amend to read:.

"7/ ....., 31 for Bosnia and Herzegovina, 32 for Latvia, 33 (vacant), 34 for Bulgaria, 35 - 36 (vacant), 37 for Turkey, 38 - 39 (vacant), 40 for The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, 41 (vacant), 42 for the European Community (approvals are granted by its member States using their respective ECE symbol), 43 for Japan, 44 (vacant), 45 for Australia, 46 for Ukraine and 47 for the Republic of South Africa. Subsequent numbers ....."

## B. JUSTIFICATION

The suffix "M/C" shall be marked on all motorcycle tyres and rims with diameter code 13 and above in order to avoid any incorrect fitting on rims for passenger car. This marking shall start in the year 2003 according to ISO/TC31/SC10 Resolution.
