# CEMA amendment to UN Reg. No.86 Background



- ▶ In European Union, road requirements for agricultural vehicles (tractors, trailers and interchangeable towed equipment resp. vehicles categories T, R and S) are covered in (EU) Reg. 167/2013.
- Work in CEMA about lighting installation is needed to take into account technical evolutions, unclarities and gaps for such vehicles.

# CEMA amendment to UN Reg. No.86 Background – GRE meeting 88



- ▶ Document first presented in April 2023: GRE-88-04 reference.
- Subsequent to GRE88, CEMA amendment was adapted to take into account the comments expressed on:
  - Special warning lamps;
  - Use of conspicuity markings instead of side marker lamps.
- Logo requirements: need for more maturity before it is introduced in agricultural vehicles.

# CEMA amendment to UN Reg. No.86 Background – GRE meeting 89



- ▶ Official document presented in October 2023: ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2023/12 reference.
- During GRE 89 were raised comments on:
  - Use of reflective materials instead of retroreflectors;
  - Maximum number of position lamps / retroreflectors;
  - Day-running lights ON when headlamps are ON.
- → Was raised a proposal to have an Ad Hoc Group on Agricultural vehicles before the SLR sessions of November and December 2023.

### CEMA amendment to UN Reg. No.86 Background – Ad Hoc Group meetings



- ▶ 2 calls held on 08 November (11h 13h) and 13 December (11h – 13h).
- Opportunity for CEMA to show the design constraints for wider vehicles.
- Agreement between parties on:
  - Removal of the use of reflective materials instead of retroreflectors;
  - Maximum number of position lamps / retroreflectors;
  - Removal of initial CEMA proposal on DRL;
  - ► For additional pairs of position lamps, introduction of a minimum distance between inner edges (100 mm).

### CEMA amendment to UN Reg. No.86 Background – Ad Hoc Group meetings



- ► Final proposal was submitted to DE for validation before official transmission to UNECE.
- Formal documents sent to GRE beginning of February 2024:
  - ► ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2023/12/Rev.1 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> series of amendments of R86;
  - ► ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2024/10 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> series of amendments of R86.
  - → Considering the date of application of the 3<sup>rd</sup> series of amendments, it was felt needed to have supplements for both 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> series of amendments.

#### **POSITION LAMPS**

- Adaptation of the requirements to take into account all vehicle dimensions:
  - Review of the maximum number of lamps;
  - Review of the requirements for additional pair(s): in particular, introduction of a minimum distance of 100 mm between inner edges.
- Alignment of the requirements as far as possible between front and rear position lamps.

#### **RETRO-REFLECTORS**

- Adaptation of the requirements to take into account all vehicle dimensions: review of the maximum number of reflectors.
- ► Alignment of the requirements as far as possible between front, rear and lateral retro-reflectors.

# CEMA amendment to UN Reg. No.86 Main amendments respect to document ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2023/12, presented at GRE 89



#### OTHER ITEMS

- Clarification of requirements for the detection in the tractor of a failing LED direction-indicator lamp on a trailer (difficulty for the detection linked to the fact that the tractor must take into account any technology of lamp).
- Clarification in the editing on the criteria for the geometric visibility for dipped-beam lamps.

#### **EDITORIAL NOTE**
