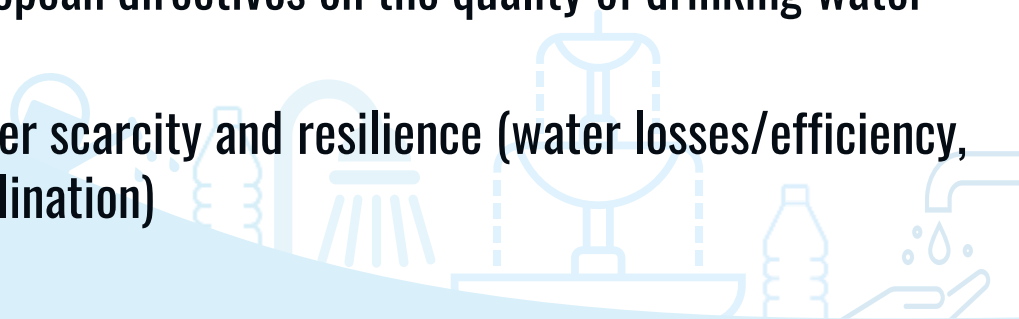

Targets revision and emerging topics

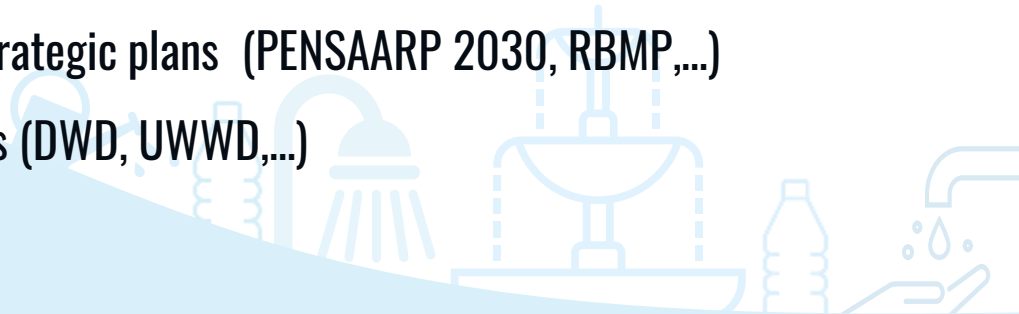
- New Strategic Plan for Water Supply, Wastewater and Stormwater Management - PENZAARP 2030
- New generation of ERSAR service quality indicators - 4th generation
- Legal provisions resulting from new European directives on the quality of drinking water and wastewater
- Growing challenges in a scenario of water scarcity and resilience (water losses/efficiency, reclaimed water, aquifer recharge, desalination)
