

# Follow up activities to the 8th Environment for Europe Ministerial Conference (Batumi, Georgia, 2016)









### Two years after:

- the Pan-European Strategic Framework for Greening the Economy and Batumi Initiative on Green Economy (BIG-E):
  - 122 commitments from 27 countries and 13 organizations on BIG- E
- the Batumi Action for Cleaner Air (BACA):
  - 109 commitments by 27 countries and 4 organizations
- Both initiatives got 21 new commitments each since the Conference

#### Mid-term review of the Batumi main outcomes:

- January 2019 (CEP-24)
- Online reporting ongoing



- Second amendment (2004) entered into force on 23 October 2017



- Budva Declaration on Environmental Democracy for Our Sustainable Future (Montenegro, 14 September 2017)
- 3 forthcoming MOPs: Water; Industrial Accidents; Espoo

  - Continuing cooperation with WHO secretariat
