
Decisions relating to the Committee on Sustainable Energy

Background

- 1. The Committee on Sustainable Energy held its twenty-eighth session on 25-27 September 2019. The report of the session is contained in document ECE/ENERGY/123.
- 2. As part of its deliberations, the Committee adopted the programme of work of the sustainable energy subprogramme for 2020, as contained in document ECE/ENERGY/2019/3;
- 3. The Committee endorsed the renewal of the mandates of the six subsidiary bodies, notably of the:
 - (a) Group of Experts on Energy Efficiency for the period 2020–2021;
 - (b) Group of Experts on Renewable Energy, for the period 2020–2021;
 - (c) Group of Experts on Cleaner Electricity Systems, for the period 2020–2021;
 - (d) Group of Experts on Coal Mine Methane, for the period 2020–2021;
 - (e) Group of Experts on Gas, for the period 2020-2021; and of the
 - (f) Expert Group on Resource Management for the period 2020–2024.
- 4. The Committee also endorsed the work plans of all the above six subsidiary bodies for 2020–2021, as contained in documents ECE/ENERGY/2019/6, ECE/ENERGY/2019/7, ECE/ENERGY/2019/8, ECE/ENERGY/2019/9, ECE/ENERGY/2019/10, and ECE/ENERGY/2019/11).
- 5. The Executive Committee is invited to approve the above decisions.
