Dear Mr Tarasenko,

I am writing to you on behalf of the Implementation Committee under the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo, 1991).

At its twenty-eighth session, held in Geneva from 10-12 September 2013, the Committee continued its consideration of the information provided by a Belarusian NGO regarding the planned construction of nuclear reactors 3 and 4 at Khmelnytska Nuclear Power Plan in Ukraine, close to the border with Belarus. The Committee considered a reply from the Government of Ukraine, received on 11 June 2013, in response to its letter (of 25 March 2013), as well as the additional information provided by Ukraine on 26 August 2013.

The Committee agreed that it would continue its consideration of the matter at its next meeting. At the request of the Committee, I am now writing to request from Ukraine to provide the following:

- (a) Clarification on the national legislation and the decision-making procedure regarding the location, design and construction of nuclear power plants;
- (b) The English translation of the national legal provisions requiring the Government of Ukraine to take into account the outcomes of the transboundary EIA procedures, including consultations and public participation. Ukraine should clarify whether it was legally possible for it to change an existing decision regarding the site, design and/or construction of a plant based on the transboundary procedures;
- (c) The full account of the transboundary EIA proceedings with each of the potentially affected countries that it had notified, in particular as regards consultations and public participation;

(d) Clarification on how the adverse transboundary environmental impact was assessed and the potentially affected Parties determined.
