RE: INTEGRATED POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL PERMIT

Observing the requirements of the Issuing, Renewal and Cancellation Rules for Integrated Pollution Prevention And Control Permits (hereinafter – the Rules) approved by the Order No.80 dated February 27, 2002, of the Minister of Environment, operators of economic activities must get an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) permit when they have installations specified by Appendices 1 and 2 of the Rules available.

If an activity operator **operates** an installation without having an IPPC permit, the operator shall be made liable according to the provisions of the law of the Republic of Lithuania. Therefore legislation provides for no requirement to have an IPPC permit during the construction stage.

The technical project for Vilnius County Regional Landfill in Kazokiškės (Elektrenai Municipality) was approved by Vilnius Region Environmental Protection Department by the Letter No.1.7-956 dated May 13, 2005, on one condition: activities would be possible only upon getting an IPPC permit according to the established procedure and having the Landfill Monitoring Plan approved.

Currently the IPPC permit No.4.7-V-02-T-10 dated January 03, 205, is issued to UAB $EK\bar{U}$ for operation of the municipal waste landfill of district significance **operating** in Kazokiškės. The IPPC permit is valid till December 31, 2005 and has nothing in common with the newly designed Vilnius County Regional Landfill.
