
On 25 July 2012, the secretariat of the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) received from you the above communication addressed to the Compliance Committee of the Convention. The communication concerns compliance by Bulgaria with the access to justice provisions of the Convention in connection with the award of injunctive relief in certain cases concerning environmental permits (mainly relating to EU Directives on environmental impact assessment, strategic environmental assessment and *habitats*). The communication was submitted in accordance with the provisions of chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.
