Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Bulgaria with the Convention in connection with the award of injunctive relief during the review of environmental permits (ACCC/C/2012/76)

On 25 July 2012, the secretariat of the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) received the above communication addressed to the Compliance Committee of the Convention. The communication concerns compliance by Bulgaria with the access to justice provisions of the Convention in connection with the award of injunctive relief in certain cases concerning environmental permits (mainly relating to EU Directives on environmental impact assessment, strategic environmental assessment and habitats). The communication was submitted in accordance with the provisions of chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.

Please find enclosed a copy of the communication, which is being forwarded to you at the request of the Committee in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 22 of the annex to decision I/7.

The Compliance Committee, having considered the admissibility of the communication at its

thirty-eighth meeting (25-28 September 2012), has on a preliminary basis determined it to be admissible in accordance with paragraph 20 of the annex to decision I/7. A copy of the preliminary determination on admissibility is attached. Please note, however, that the Committee has not reached any conclusions with respect to the compliance issues referred to in the communication.

Having regard to paragraph 23 of the annex to decision I/7, you are kindly invited to submit to the Committee, as soon as possible but at the latest within five months of the date of this letter (i.e. by 30 March 2013), any written explanations or statements clarifying the matter referred to in the communication and describing any response that may have been made in the meantime.
