Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the United Kingdom with the access to justice provisions of the Convention in relation to the Legal Aid, Sentencing and the Punishment of Offenders Act 2012

(ACCC/C/2013/85)

and

Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the United Kingdom in connection with access to justice in private nuisance proceedings (ACCC/C/2013/86)

At its forty-eighth meeting (Geneva, 24-27 March 2015), the Compliance Committee considered in closed session the comments received on its draft findings forwarded to the parties on 23 February 2015. In this regard, comments were received from the communicant of communication ACCC/C/2013/86 on 9 March 2015 and the Party concerned on 23 March 2015. No comments were received from the communicant of communication ACCC/C/2013/85.

In the light of the comments received, the Committee prepared a revised draft of its findings and requested the secretariat to forward the revised draft findings to the parties for their consideration and possible further comments pursuant to paragraph 34 of the annex to decision I/7. The Committee indicated that it intended to finalize and adopt the findings through its electronic decision-making procedure prior to its forty-ninth meeting (Geneva, 30 June - 3 July 2015).
