I would like to draw the Compliance Committee's attention to two recent developments in Kazakhstan in relation to the communication ACCC/C/2013/88.

The Kok Zhailau site has been excluded from the list of proposed list of competition venues of the revised concept set by the City of Almaty for hosting the Winter Olympic Games of 2022. On 16 January 2015 International Olympic Committee informed the Ecological Society "Green Salvation" about it. Please find enclosed the scanned copy of the letter from International Olympic Committee.

However the Almaty municipality is still considering to develop the ski resort at this location and held on 19 January 2015 public hearing on the project of construction of an automobile road to it. Several dozens of project opponents had no access to the venue of the hearing because almost all available seats were preoccupied by project proponents even before the registration time. Also the developer failed to comply with the EIA Instruction and the Aarhus Convention. You can find more detailed information about in the enclosed letter submitted by Ecoforum of Kazakhstan and the Ecological Society "Green Salvation" to the Municipality Department of Automobile Roads.
