Subject: Request for disclosure of documentation in the case of completion of Mochovce in Bratislava, at the office of the Nuclear Regulatory Authority (Bajkalská 27)

Following the judgment of the Supreme Court of the Slovak Republic on the appeal of the civic association Greenpeace Slovakia and subsequent reopening of the decision procedure on the completion of the construction of Mochovce, we ask the Nuclear Regulatory Authority of the Slovak Republic (NRA), as the competent building authority for disclosure of documentation in Bratislava in the building of the NRA on Bajkalska 27.

On 08/21/2013 the NRA sent us the notice "*Nuclear Power Plant Mochovce VVER 4x440 MW 3. Construction - notice to reopen the decision procedure concerning the decision to permit construction before finishing*", which states, inter alia: "*As for the other parties, they have option to get acquainted with the documentation, from which will be excluded all sensitive information, from 15.10.2013 in the information center of the NPP Mochovce, where will be the necessary documentation for the authorization procedure [available] for consultation.*" Since the documentation is made accessible by the building authority – the Nuclear Regulatory Authority of Slovakia, and the appeal on the basis of which the Supreme Court of the Slovak Republic issued its decision on 27.6.2013, case no. 5SŽp/21/2012, has nothing to do with the Information Center of Mochovce of Slovenske Elektrarne, we see no reason that the available documentation is accessible only in objects of Slovenske Elektrarne a.s.
