Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Norway in connection with access to the legal assessment carried out prior to the adoption of the Nature Diversity Act (ACCC/C/2013/93)

On 26 June 2013, the secretariat of the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decisionmaking and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) received from you the above communication addressed to the Compliance Committee of the Convention. The communication concerns compliance by Norway with the provisions of the Convention in connection with the alleged refusal by the Party concerned of the communicant's request for access to the legal assessment carried out prior to the adoption of the Nature Diversity Act. The communication was submitted in accordance with the provisions of chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.
