Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the Czech Republic with provisions of the Convention on public participation and access to justice

At its forty-third meeting (Geneva, 17-20 December 2013), the Compliance Committee agreed to defer its determination of provisional admissibility with respect to the above communication in order to seek further clarification on the substance of the communication.

In particular, the Committee noted there appeared to be substantial similarities between the allegations made in your communication and those considered by the Committee in its findings on ACCC/C/2010/50 concerning the Czech Republic.
