Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Spain in connection with the change of activity for a cement plant to process solid waste and sewage (ACCC/C/2014/99)

I write to inform you that on 15 June 2016, the Compliance Committee agreed its draft findings regarding communication ACCC/C/2014/99 through its electronic decision-making procedure.

The draft findings are now forwarded at the request of the Committee for your consideration and possible comments pursuant to paragraph 34 of the annex to decision I/7. The Committee intends to finalize and adopt the findings at or before its fifty-fourth meeting (Geneva, 26-29 September 2016). Given the lengthy timeframe until the sixth session of the Meeting of the Parties, Committee considers that the making of recommendations directly to the Party concerned, coupled with timely action by the Party to implement such recommendations, would enable the matters to be resolved in the most expeditious way.
