The inquiry

We kindly request the Agriculture Chamber to take a formal position with regard to the building of the high-voltage 400 kV double-track line, Transformer/Switching Station 'Ełk' – state border with Lithuania (direction ALYTUS) regarding to the impact of the electromagnetic field on the cattle breeding (especially its healthiness), plant production in the range of the electromagnetic fields of this line as well as at the area of the protected zone and especially the impact on the farmers working there. We would like to know if the farmers signing the agreement do not deny the obligations arising from EU directives? Will the cross-compliance requirements be fulfilled by the farmers with regard to the environment protection, animal healthiness and welfare, the protection of soil and permanent grassland? We would be grateful if the Agriculture Chamber would this the case as a matter of urgency.
