Dear Ms Marshall,

In relation to the request for clarification regarding questions 9) and 10) of your letter dated 30 January 2018 we would respond as follows:

With regard to question 9) WWF is not aware of the existence of recent judicial decisions in which the court did not require non-governmental organizations to pay the fee/tax (*contributo unificato*) as provided by Article 13, paragraph 6 *bis*.

Concerning question 10) appeals against refusal of access to environmental information are exempted from the fee/tax (*contributo unificato*) under Italian law. There are no other exemptions for actions pursuant to art. 9, paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of the Convention.

We hope this information is helpful and look forward to hearing from you in due course.
