Re: Communication concerning compliance by Ireland with articles 5 and 6 of the Convention with respect to Dumping at Sea Permits (ACCC/C/2016/139)

At its fifty-ninth meeting (Geneva, 11-15 December 2017), the Committee noted that in its response of 5 May 2017 to the above communication, the Party concerned had challenged the admissibility of the communication.
