





EU Services	European Communities (Access to Information on the Environment Regulations), 2007 to 2014. (S.I. No. 130 of 2007, S.I. No. 643 of 2011 & S.I. No. 815 of 2014)
EU Law & Policy	The Access to Information on the Environment Regulations give you the right to access environmental information held by or for the EPA and other Public Authorities. A person can make a request that normally must be made as soon as possible but at the latest one month from the date of receipt of the request.
About the EPA	What can I ask for?
Contact Information	You can ask for environmental information held by or for the EPA. Environmental information is defined in the Regulations and determines what is available under the A.E. Regulations.
How to Access Environmental Information	What is the definition of environmental information?
Decisions	Environmental information can be held in any material form, including written, visual, audio or electronic, and/or gathered as follows:
Emissions	In the case of the elements of the environment, such as air and atmosphere, water, soil, land, vegetation and wild life, including waters, lesser and greater birds, habitat diversity and ecological processes, including generally living organisms and the interaction among these elements;
Environmental Assessments	In the case such substances, energy, radiation or waste, including radioactive waste substances, its origins and other substances into the environment, affecting or likely to affect the environment;
Environmental Agreements	In relation to being administrative measures, such as plans, applications, programmes, environmental agreements, and/or measures affecting or likely to affect the environment and for the purposes referred to in (a) to (d) of sections 1(1) and (2) 99, as well as measures or activities designed to protect these elements;
