Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Poland with the provisions of the Convention on access to justice in relation to forest management plans (ACCC/C/2017/154)

On 14 November 2017, the secretariat of the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) received from your organization, supported by the six other non-governmental organizations copied below, the above communication addressed to the Compliance Committee of the Convention. The communication concerns compliance by Poland with the provisions of the Convention in connection with its alleged failure to provide for access to justice in relation to forest management plans. The communication was submitted in accordance with the provisions of chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.
