SS/40/09/2017), please find enclosed the scans of the multiannual farm and hunting plans (WLPH) for the years 2017-2027, made for the hunting districts on the area of the Regional Directorate of the State Forests in Katowice. The scans demonstrate that the plans were approved by the parties taking part in their preparation, in accordance with the relevant laws in force. The multiannual farm and hunting plans were developed through numerous meetings with representatives of local governments, the Polish Hunting Association and the State Forests.

Regarding your second request for public information of 29 September 2017 (reference SS/39/09/2017), please be informed that the multiannual farm and hunting plans (WŁPH) have not been subject to a strategic environmental impact assessment procedure (SEA) under Directive 2001/42/EC of the Parliament and the Council on the assessment of the effects of certain plans and programmes on the environment of 27 June 2001. The decision not to carry out environmental impact assessments for the WŁPH is based on the fact that those plans are not subject to strategic environmental impact assessments because they are not mentioned in art. 46 and art. 47 of the Act of 3 October on the Provision of Information on the Environment, Public Participation in Environmental Protection and Environmental Impact Assessment as requiring such an assessment.
