Dear Mr. Raposo Victoriano, dear Mr. Vieira,

At its sixty-fourth meeting (Geneva, 1-5 July 2019), the Compliance Committee considered the preliminary admissibility of communication PRE/ACCC/C/2019/166 concerning Portugal submitted by “Plataforma Algarve Livre de Petróleo” on 28 January 2019.

I write to inform you that, after taking into account the information received, the Committee has determined the communication to be inadmissible in accordance with paragraphs 20(d) and 21 of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties due to a failure to sufficiently use available domestic remedies. If you consider that the Committee’s determination that the communication is inadmissible was based on a manifest error, you may request a reconsideration of the Committee’s determination of inadmissibility. Any such request must be submitted to the secretariat, with a reasoning of no more than 1200 words (2 pages A4 size), no later than 20 August 2019, i.e. five weeks from today. Please note that a request for reconsideration is not an opportunity to provide information or evidence that could have been provided earlier.
