**Subject:** PRE/ACCC/C/2019/169 (Hungary) - outcome of Committee's deliberations on preliminary admissibility at its 65th meeting

At its sixty-fifth meeting (Geneva, 4-8 November 2019), the Compliance Committee considered the preliminary admissibility of communication PRE/ACCC/C/2019/169 concerning Hungary submitted by Österreichisches Ökologie-Institut, Umweltinstitut München e.V. and others on 20 May 2019.

I write to inform you that, after taking into account the information received, the Committee has determined the communication to be inadmissible in accordance with paragraphs 20(d) and 21 of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties due to a failure to use domestic remedies.

If the communicants consider that the Committee's determination that the communication is inadmissible was based on a manifest error, they may request a reconsideration of the Committee's determination of admissibility. Any such request must be submitted to the secretariat, with a reasoning of no more than 1200 words (2 pages A4 size), no later than five weeks from today, i.e., Thursday, 19 December 2019. Please note that a request for reconsideration is not an opportunity to provide information on either subsequent developments or evidence that could have been provided earlier.
