Although citizens' participation has become an integral part of environmental proceedings it is an increasingly contentious issue. Recent judgements by the European Court of Justice show that there is urgent need to act and speeding up processes is an order of the day. In this field of tension the seminar will look into the relevant legislation area and analyse it in workshops by means of current legal decisions. In this way recommendations for an Aarhus-compliant decision-making practice are to be acquired.

- Is there a right to clean air?
- Which rights do environmental organisations have in water law?
- What is the extent of public participation in nature conservation law?
- What should be taken into account from a procedural point of view (preclusion, party involvement, subsequent right of appeal?)
