The attached letter has been received from the communicant of communication ACCC/C/2014/102 on the basis of paragraph 7 of decision VI/8c. To recall, in this paragraph the Meeting of the Parties noted with appreciation "that when evaluating the implementation of the Party concerned of the above recommendations, the Committee will take into account any information received from members of the public or other sources about future incidents of alleged penalization, persecution or harassment contrary to article 3, paragraph 8, of the Convention together with any information provided by the Party concerned regarding those alleged incidents."

The Chair of the Compliance Committee has requested the secretariat to forward the letter to Belarus for its comments to be submitted to the secretariat by Friday 4 May 2018.

Further, Belarus is requested to take the information contained in the communicant's letter into account in its progress report to be submitted on 1 October 2018.
