Many thanks also to the Frank Bold for this interesting information about the situation of Czech Law. That's the first information I as communicant of C71 got since the decisions of the Committee. If I understand it right, the German individuals of the public concerned (means natural person's like me) are by Czech Law completely out of any further public participation. Means no technical data were accessible to them in the EIA procedure Temelin 3,4.

My apologize that I weren't able to participate at the meeting. At the same time I had a phone conference concerning the German search for a nuclear waste repository. The region of the Fichtelgebirge is a possible site in granite.
