**Re: Decision VI/8h concerning compliance by Romania
with its obligations under the Aarhus Convention**

The Compliance Committee under the Convention on Access to Information, Public participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) has asked me to write to you as a courtesy to remind you that, in accordance with paragraph 8(a) of decision VI/8h of the Meeting of the Parties, Romania is requested to submit to the Committee its second progress report by **1 October 2019** on the measures it has by that date taken, and the results achieved, to implement the recommendations in paragraphs 2(a)-(c), 3, 4, and 7(a)(i)-(iv), (b)-(d) of decision VI/8h.

The Committee has also asked me to remind you that, as the Chair of the Committee explained during the open session on decision VI/8h at the Committee's sixty-third meeting (Geneva, 11-15 March 2019), all the measures to implement decision VI/8h must be taken and reported on by no later than **1 October 2020** in order that they can be taken into consideration by the Committee in its report on decision VI/8h to the seventh session of the Meeting of the Parties.

Finally, should Romania demonstrate to the Committee that it has fully met the requirements of decision VI/8h by the time of its final progress report due on 1 October 2020, the Committee will report that fact to the seventh session of the Meeting of the Parties. There would then be no need for a further decision on those points to be adopted at the seventh session.
