## **Decisions**

- National Programme on implementing targets set under the Protocol the Steering Committee
  takes note on the progress achieved and endorses the suggested timeline for the finalization and
  official approval of the document until 30 June 2016 as well as a number of promotional
  activities to be carried out thereafter
- Trainings for water operators and water users associations the Steering Committee welcomes
  the successful completion of activities under this project component as well as the plans for
  publication of the train-the-trainer manual and its presentation at the conclusion meeting
  scheduled for December 2015
- Norms and standards for small scale supplies the Steering Committee welcomes the
  significant progress with the development of a number of norms and standards in the area of
  small scale water supplies and sanitation and endorse the suggested timeline for the finalization
  and official approval of the documents until 30 June 2016. The meeting also takes note of the
  possible future needs identified in this area
- Clearing House under the Protocol on Water and Health and awareness-raising campaigns welcomes the functioning of the Clearing House and takes note of the awareness-raising activities implemented and promotion material distributed in 2015
- Partnerships and platforms for policy dialogue and decision-making the Steering Committee
  welcomes cooperation and coordination between the Ministry of Environment and Ministry of
  Health as well as other relevant governmental authorities and agrees to have its final meeting
  under the current phase of the project in spring 2016
- Promotion of the Moldovan experience through regional dialogue the Steering Committee
  acknowledges the wealth of experience accumulated in the Republic of Moldova with regard to
  the implementation of the Protocol on Water and Health and welcomes the initiative of
  contributing case studies on selected topics to the publication Collection of good practices on
  target setting and reporting, led by Switzerland, to be submitted to the fourth session of the
  Meeting of the Parties to the Protocol on Water and Health (Bern, 14-16 November 2016)
