Scope and Aim of this Side Event

The concept note "Access to information and public participation under the Protocol on Water and Health", resulting from the workshop on public participation in Bucharest on 15 and 16 June 2010, identifies needs, obligations, best practices and challenges in the area of capacity building, access to information and public participation under the PWH.

This event will highlight lessons learned and similar problem analyses in these areas from other processes, in particular the European Union Water Initiative (EUWI) for the EECCA region, the European Union's Water Framework Directive, and the Aarhus Convention's new Task Force on Public Participation in Decision-making. Furthermore other questions will be discussed, such as what is the added value of capacity building and PP, how is it financed, and can synergies be created between PWH and these other processes.

The speakers will address the benefits of the river-basin approach in the target setting process under the PWH. The event will result in recommendations to the Meeting of Parties of the PWH.
