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EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. Following the discussions concerning the programme of work at the last session (TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/92, paras. 98-100), the autumn 2003 session of the Joint Meeting will be divided into two parts:
 - First part: 1 to 10 September 2003;
 - Second part: 13 to 17 October 2003.

This agenda concerns both parts, and so as to make the most of the working time, the adoption of the report of both parts will take place on 17 October.

- 2. As a result of this reorganization, the session of the Joint Meeting scheduled in Bern from 22 to 26 March 2004 is cancelled. The seventy-fifth session of the Working Party on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (WP.15), scheduled in Geneva from 3 to 7 November 2003, is postponed until the week of 19 to 23 January 2004.
- 3. The annotated agenda and the list of documents will be circulated under the symbol TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/2003/60.
- 4. A detailed timetable will be circulated later.

- 5. At its last session in 2002, the Joint Meeting elected Mr. C. Pfauvadel (France) as Chairman and Mr. H. Rein (Germany) as Vice-Chairman for 2003.
- 6. UN/ECE documents (other than agendas or reports) with the symbol TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/ are circulated by OCTI in German under the symbol OCTI/RID/GT-III/ followed by the same document number. As part of the secretariat's efforts to reduce expenditure, documents distributed prior to the session by mail will not be available in the conference room for distribution to session participants. Delegates are kindly requested to bring their copies of documents to the meeting.
- 7. The documentation will be available on the UN/ECE web site (www.unece.org/trans/danger/danger.htm) in English, French and Russian.
- 8. If necessary, the Joint Meeting would like an ad hoc working group to meet concurrently with it to consider documents concerning tanks (item 7), after the item has been discussed in plenary.
- 9. An ad hoc working group is scheduled to work outside the times of the plenary session to consider documents concerning standards (item 6), in accordance with the mandate to be decided by the Joint Meeting (see TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/88-OCTI/RID/GT-III/2002-A, paras. 94 and 95).
