## Specification of hazard labels and marks

## Submitted by the International Air Transport Association (IATA)

## Proposal

1. Based on the discussion of INF.17, the following is proposed to remove reference to the line on hazard labels being a minimum of 2 mm thick and also to provide some tolerance for the distance from the line forming the diamond on hazard labels being 5 mm to the edge of the label.
5.2.2.2.1.1.2 The label shall be in the form of a square set at an angle of 45 degrees (diamond-shaped). The minimum dimensions shall be $100 \mathrm{~mm} \times 100 \mathrm{~mm}$. and the minimerm width of the There shall be a line inside the edge forming the diamond shall be 2 mm . The line inside the edge-which shall be parallel and [approximately] 5 mm from the outside of that line to the edge of the label.
