

- ➤ IW&river-sea fleet ~ 3000 vessels
- > Total(DWT) ~ 6 mln tons

- Russian IWW 101,7 thousand km
- > European DWRS -6,5 thousand km



MISSION




- ➤ to eliminate obstacles for shipping, arising from national and international regulations

EUROPEAN WATER TRANSPORTATION RING




Challenges:

- > Legal issues
- > Safety of navigation requirements/standards
- ➤ Restricted navigation periods. Weather & ice conditions
- Sea routes
- Compliance with all Maritime Conventions (SOLAS, MARPOL, BWM etc.)
- Visa/border control procedures
- ➤ Insurance & liability issues, etc.
