



# GRSG-113 Agenda point 5 – Awareness of Vulnerable Road Users proximity



### Inf Group management

- European Commission/Japan co-chairmanship, with OICA as Secretariat
- > 3 meetings to date, next scheduled in November in Tokyo
- ➤ Aim: "Enhancement of the driver's ability to detect vulnerable road users (VRU)"
- Scope: vehicles of categories M and N
- Limited to detection and warning systems
- ➤ 4 steps for regulatory outcomes to GRSG (see GRSG-113-14)
  - 115<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2018: BSIS
  - 116<sup>th</sup> Apr. 2019: Rearward motion
  - 118<sup>th</sup> Apr. 2020: Forward motion Driving straight or taking off
  - 120<sup>th</sup> Apr. 2021: Direct vision



#### Main topics

- Timing: not frozen yet (EC)
- > Scope: depends on each topic
- > Data collection:
  - OICA as pilot
  - Necessary for determining the priorities
- > HMI: identified as a major item: How? and when?
  - Warning or Informing the driver to be discussed for each scenario
- > Switch-off capabilities: to be defined
- Regulatory approach: separate new regulation vs. amendment to UN R46?



#### State of play after 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting

- > Forward driving:
  - 1. Transport for London (TfL)
  - 2. Promote direct view, eye contact
  - 3. VRU-Proxi to take full account of the conclusions of the TfL study
- > Rearward driving:
  - 1. J to provide additional justifications to their proposal GRSG-111-23 at 4<sup>th</sup> meeting
  - 2. VRU-Proxi to investigate rear-view cameras + sensors combination
- ➤ Data task-force: OICA as pilot



#### State of play after 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting

- > Establishment of 3 task-forces:
  - 1. Regulatory text drafting focusing on BSIS
    - Pilot: BASt (Germany)
    - Aims: Re-structure the text, improve test method
    - Deadline: GRSG-114
  - 2. Data collection (confirmation of 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting)
    - Pilot: OICA
    - Aim: define the priorities of the group
    - See GRSG-113-27
    - Deadline: VRU-Proxi-04 (Nov 17 Tokyo)



## State of play after 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting (cont'd)

- 3. Human-Machine Interface (HMI)
  - Pilot: OICA
  - Aims: BSIS HMI text proposal
  - Deadline: GRSG-114 (April 2018)
- > Terms of Reference revised as per GRSG-113-14
- Final regulatory proposal limited to vehicle approvals (1st step)
