The Working Party on Transport Trends and Economics (WP.5) at its 32nd session (Geneva, 2–4 September 2019, ECE/TRANS/WP.5/66, para. 60) recommended the establishment of the new Group of Experts and adopted the terms of reference, as provided below. WP.5 also requested the secretariat to submit the terms of reference to ITC for their approval.
